

RULES FOR ROULETTE

Dealers call for all bets to be made. All bets are placed before the ball is dropped into the spinning roulette wheel. The roulette layout consists of 36 numbers arranged in three columns of 12 each. Betting is done with chips which are purchased at the table. A person may bet that the number will be odd or even, red or black, from 1-18, or from 19-36.

Chips are placed on the line at the bottom of the appropriate column to indicate the bet. To bet on four numbers, the chips are placed at the axis of those -four numbers. To bet on three numbers, chips are placed on the outside line of the row of three numbers. To bet on one number, chips are placed on that one square. Other possible bets and all odds for payoffs are posted at the table.
